

On Tuesday June 10, 2025, the Honourable Chief Minister of Maharashtra, Shri Devendra Fadnavis, initiated the launch of the National Common Mobility Card (NCMC) for Mumbai Metro Line 3, known as the Aqua Line, aiming to integrate the city's public transportation networks.
